The investment activities are divided into two operational groups, represented by Capital Research and Management Company ("CRMC") and Capital Group International, Inc. ("CGII"). CRMC is a U.S.-based investment adviser that manages the American Funds family of mutual funds. CGII is the parent company of five companies that serve as investment managers to various institutional clients around the globe: Capital Guardian Trust Company in the U.S., Capital International, Inc. in the U.S. and Singapore, Capital International Limited in the United Kingdom, Capital International Sarl in Switzerland and Capital International K.K. in Japan.</p> <p>Neither CGC nor any of its subsidiaries own shares of the company for their own account. Rather, the shares reported in this Notification are owned by accounts under the discretionary investment management of one or more of the investment management companies described above.
